

Low Income Weatherization Rebate

Rebate Summary:

To assist in the weatherization of homes served by Sawnee EMC, in which the residents are deemed low income, Sawnee may award a maximum of \$200 to a local community organization who will provide weatherization assistance to the member. A follow-up inspection is required by a Sawnee EMC Energy Services Representative (ESR).

Requirements

- Complete the application form and fax or mail it to Sawnee EMC, Attn: Energy Services, 543 Atlanta Hwy, Cumming, GA 30040. Fax Number: 678-513-8106.
- An ESR will set up an initial inspection with a member of the organization to do a walk-through of the home to see what weatherization is planned and give any suggestions on any additional upgrades.
- The community organization performing weatherization must be non-profit with verifiable IRS documentation.
- The person whose home is being weatherized must be a Sawnee EMC customer and deemed low-income with verifiable IRS documentation (as defined by the Georgia State Energy Assistance Program).
- This rebate will cover materials used up to a maximum of \$200. The receipts for materials used must be made available to the Energy Services Representative (ESR) at the time of the final inspection of the home.
- After all of the work has been completed by the community organization, the ESR will be contacted and a final inspection will be scheduled.
- The ESR will inspect the home verifying that the receipts coincide with the work completed on the home.
- After the inspection and ESR approval, a check will be made out to the community organization for the cost of the materials, up to a maximum of \$200. The check will be mailed to said organization, typically within 10 days of the final inspection.
